June 18 we kick off a new summer sermon series: **Romans: Connecting to Grace.** This 7-week series will focus on Romans, chapters 5-8.

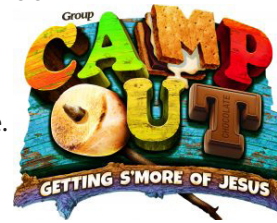
