He was calling to ask Mark if his church would be interested in their two properties, valued at around 2 million dollars. The GEBC didn't want to sell their properties to the church. They wanted to give their properties to the church.

This is what Mark writes about this experience. "What profoundly impacted me was the fact that GEBC was courageous and generous enough to give its building to another church. We were surprised and humbled beyond
