

# **Spiritual Practice — Gratitude**

The spiritual practice of gratitude can help us witness God's fingerprints and bring us back from places of desolation. Even when we are not in a season of struggle, it can be important to refocus our attention on the good in our lives. Here are a few options of how you can practice gratitude.

- 1. At the end of each day, write down three things you are grateful for that happened. It could be conversations you had, food you ate, or simply that you woke up this morning.
- 2. Take a picture of people, places, or things each day that you are thankful for, or for which give you joy. Share the picture on social media or send it to a friend. Or, at the end of this week, make a photo collage of everything for which you were able to give God thanks.
- 3. Each time something happens that makes you happy or gives you joy, take a moment to say, "Thank you," to God. These moments of prayer help center us on God's presence each day.
